RESOLUTION

Participants of the 5<sup>th</sup> International Capacity Building Workshop –"**Project Management – Cross-sectoral Collaboration**", organised by ICOMOS Georgia and partners from Armenia, Georgia, and Ukraine in Tbilisi, 16-17 July 2013, within the framework of the Regional Cooperation for Cultural Heritage development:

Commend the European Union for its support to the event;

Acknowledge the importance of improvement of the project management system and cross-sectoral collaboration, in the field of environmental and spatial development, within the EaP Region, through capacity building activities and strengthening of communication skills of different stakeholders.

Participants of the workshop recommend action on capacity building, promotion of the best practice and policy making on regional level as follows:

#### **Capacity Building**

Effective, continues capacity activity needs to be developed for project management skill building through:

- targeted workshops for different stakeholders (owner, planner, architect, contractor, engineer, craftsmen, expert, researcher, government, project manager, donor);
- introduction of the training in Project Management for different disciplines involved in spatial and environmental development on the university level.

Special need in establishment of educational programmes at high education level for structural engineers, construction engineers and civil engineers in integrated conservation, as well as in project management should be addressed urgently.

# **Policy**

To improve heritage policymaking with emphasis on establishment of adequate environment for the better quality of development project results through:

- establishment of the balance of power and responsibility between stakeholders involved in the process – to ensure adequate architectural supervision of the construction activity;
- based on the analysis of current situation to create a system of specific regulations and norms including promotion of environmentally friendly new technologies.

#### **Best practice**

It is important to share the international experience and best practice for strengthening the Project Management Capacity Building in EaP Region through development of professional network and international programmes;

It is crucial to identify positive cases within the region and to support them through promotion on regional and international levels;

In this regard:

The workshop participants acknowledge that the Redevelopment of the Radomysl Castle at the King's road via Regia in Ukraine is one of the best practices of private initiative in safeguard of Cultural Heritage and its development;

This case proves to be an exceptional testimony of feasibility of integrated approach in development through heritage recourse rehabilitation for the sustainable safeguarding of the wider context of the heritage - its tangible and intangible values;

Therefore Participants of the 5th International Capacity Building Workshop – "Project Management – Cross-Sectoral Collaboration" appeal to the Ministry of Culture of Ukraine and relevant authorities of the Country to support the project through providing the legal protection (relevant listing procedure according the legal context of the Country) to the tradition of Ukrainian Home Icons as for intangible heritage of the Ukraine with purpose for future nomination of this unique heritage on the UNESCO Intangible World Heritage List;
